**Pope Francis:** 'Take a moment to examine your compassion for others, those around you and those in the world. What can you do to help others in concrete ways in the next couple of weeks?'

### How can I ever thank you? (3)

Here is the beginning of St.Paul's Letter to the Ephesians, which spells out what precisely we have to thank our God for:

"Blessed be God the Father of Our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with all the spiritual blessings of heaven in Christ. Before the world was made he chose us, chose in Christ, to be holy and spotless, and to live through love in his presence, determining that we should become his adopted sons, through Jesus Christ, for his own kind purposes, to make us praise the glory of his grace, his free gift to us in the Beloved, in whom, through his blood, we gain our freedom, the forgiveness of our sins. Such is the richness of the grace he so showered on us in all wisdom and insight. He has let us know the mystery of his purpose, the hidden plan he so kindly made in Christ from the beginning, to act upon when times had run their course to the end; that he would bring everything together under Christ as head, everything in the heavens and everything on earth. and it is in him that we are claimed as God's own, chosen from the beginning, under the predetermined plan of the one who guides all things as he decides by his own will, chosen to be, for his greater glory, the people who would put their hopes in Christ before he came."

The life of true discipleship of Our Lord begins and ends with perceiving the need to thank him for his goodness to us all, and that thanks is expressed most deeply in living in his way and accepting his loving invitation to "do this in memory of me". *(To be continued)*
