### Letters from Pope Francis / Bishop

**Patrick** - please be sure to take home the letter sent to the Church by Pope Francis in the last fortnight. Bishop Patrick sent the following to his priests on August 17:

"In the past few days, reports have been published detailing large scale abuse of young people by priests in Pennsylvania, Ampleforth and Downside. As Pope Francis has said, these reports fill us with shame and sorrow at the morally reprehensible and criminal behaviour of the priests and the terrible suffering inflicted by them on so many young people, and at the scandalous failure of so many of our leaders - bishops and abbots - to deal adequately with these crimes when they were brought to their attention. I wish you to know - and for you to be able to say to your parishioners - that I personally share that shame and sorrow and that I am praying for the victims. Alongside you, I am committed to ensuring that any issues raised in this diocese will be dealt with immediately and appropriately. More importantly, I would like to reassure you, my brother priests, that I have you all very much in my thoughts, and that I will be praying for you all at this difficult time." + Patrick
