November Dead List — forms are available today for our November Dead List. Please fill in the names of your family and friends you would like to be remembered and hand the form in with a donation for Masses to the sacristy. The list will be published throughout November and the Masses are said during the year. This is a very nice way of remembering our loved ones.

First Holy Communion — parents of children eligible to make their First Communion this year should have received a letter from school. If you have not done so, please collect one from the sacristy. You will be asked to make a formal application on your children's behalf and indicate your willingness to support them in the coming weeks. The sessions for children and parents who have made application will begin on Monday October 29. This year, the Hinckley catechists have decided to adopt the system used in Earl Shilton, namely to have preparation sessions for children and parents on a Monday evening between 6.15 to 7.15pm over an 18 week period between now and next summer. This may be a bit of a challenge but it is the only way to ensure that both our children and their parents are properly and reverently prepared for a life with Our Lord in the Eucharist.

Baptism Preparation — the first programme is now complete, but a number of families have asked for their children to be baptised before our next sessions in February. Thankfully Rev. Robin and Marina have agreed to put on two more preparatory sessions on Nov. 4 and November 11 at 4.30pm. Normally we will not do this but on this occasion they have offered to make an exception. No baptism will be arranged until the parents have attended the two mandatory preparation sessions. After November the next preparatory sessions will be in February and May.
