Holyday of Obligation – Thursday, the Feast of All Saints. Please see panel for the times of Masses. in our three parishes. There will be an extra Mass on Friday at 6.30pm for those who wish to commemorate their dead on All Souls Day.

First Holy Communion - . The sessions for children and parents who have made application for will begin on Monday this week at 6.30pm (please not the change in time). This year, the Hinckley catechists have decided to adopt the system used in Earl Shilton, namely to have preparation sessions for children and parents on a Monday evening between over an 18 week period between now and next summer. This may be a bit of a challenge but it is the only way to ensure that both our children and their parents are properly and reverently prepared for a life with Our Lord in the Eucharist.
