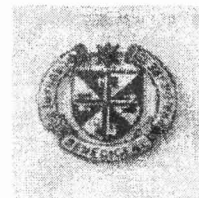

CAFOD Boxes – will be available for you to take and use at home during Lent

Stations of the Cross – on Fridays and Sundays during Lent at 6.00pm on Fridays and 6.30pm on Sundays. We would like the different parish groups to lead the stations if possible.

CAFOD's Matching

Scheme – to mark CAFOD's 50th anniversary, H.M.Government has offered to match any donation given to the charity between February and July this year. This means that every penny given will be matched and is a wonderful opportunity, hence the importance of the CAFOD boxes, frugal lunches and the Family Fast Day collection, which you may also Gift Aid if you wish.

The Society of St.Vincent de Paul (SVP) –

was set up in Paris by a 19th century French student, Blessed Frederic Ozanam to cater for the needs of those who were poor in the city. It quickly spread all over the world and there are 'conferences' in nearly every Catholic parish. The work has changed somewhat in that while we still try to help families and individuals in need where possible and necessary, the main thrust of our efforts is in visiting elderly and housebound people at home and in hospital, doing shopping with or for them and taking them for hospital appointments. We meet once a fortnight on a Monday evening and would be very glad to have some new members as the number of elderly parishioners is growing, and we are finding it a great burden to maintain our level of care for everyone. Some of our parishioners are very lonely and need our friendship, so the work is urgent. If you think you could spare a little time for someone else, please contact Kathleen Bradley on 230400. We have not asked for the customary twice yearly collection for our funds for several years as we received a legacy, which has now been used up, so there will be a voluntary retiring collection next weekend, if you don't mind.
