A unique 'interactive' feature of the production is that the audience are invited to sing the songs with the cast, who are at presented very excited at the opportunity of presenting it again. Tickets are £5 for adults, £3 concessions and, because of generous sponsorship, the entire proceeds will be distributed to charities in Hinckley, Loughborough and Leicester just in time for Christmas.
