This take on an original idea by C.S.Lewis in his book "The Screwtape Letters" is in fact a hilarious meditation of modern life, particularly in 'the cathedral of sin' (the school playground!) which we hope you will all enjoy. Performances are on Thursday January 3 and Friday January 4 at 7.30pm and Sunday January 6 at 4.30pm. Tickets are now on sale (Adults £4; Concessions £3 – it's much cheaper than the panto!!) and the proceeds from the production will be given to Lawrence House. We apologise for the incorrect date on the poster – the last performance is on Sunday and not Saturday at 4.30pm. If you would like to take a poster to publicize the event, please do so.
