The future of Churches

together – we have the AGM for Churches Together on Monday March 11 at 7.30pm in St. John's, at which point John Moore will step down as chairman after 9 years, for which we thank him enormously. This means there will be no chairman, secretary or treasurer, which roles are necessary for Churches Together to continue. They have been advertised around the churches but no one has as yet come forward offering to fulfil them. If any of you feel you might be willing to take on one of these responsibilities then please tell Fr. Frank immediately. If they cannot be filled then the ministers propose a different route for us. This would involve formally closing down the organisation of Churches Together in Hinckley and district and focussing on the monthly breakfast meetings of the church leaders, shared services throughout the year – January, Holy week, Pentecost and Christmas Carols – outreach, which includes AlterNativity and Street Pastors, and starting a new gathering twice a year of prayer for our town and praise to our God. This would mean a looser organisation and would need the support of a communications officer. The leadership of the clergy would probably be rotated. a decision will be made at the AGM on March 11 and you are invited to come along for that gathering. Sadly our Hinckley community is not as committed to this enterprise as we should be – note the attendance at the recent service – but hopefully this will change in the future.
