### Message from Cardinal Vincent Nichols

"I ask that at Mass on Saturday evening, you add a prayer or a comment uniting your parish to Pope Francis and all taking part in that liturgy so that together we ask the Lord's pardon for our failings. On Sunday morning, at 8.30 am UK time, there will be a special celebration of Holy Mass, seeking the Lord's blessings on the work accomplished and for the challenges ahead. Please do unite your parish Sunday celebration of Mass with this intention."

### Lent in St. Dominic's Community – we

hope for a very fruitful Lent together, sharing in various activities within our communities:

**Ash Wednesday** – Mass with blessing and distribution of ashes will take place in Hinckley at 9.30am, Market Bosworth at 11.00am and Earl Shilton at 7.00pm. Today is also a day of Fasting and Abstinence.

**Frugal Lunches** – each Friday in the Mary Forryan Centre after 12.00pm Mass beginning on Friday March 8. We will be joined by some pupils from St. Martin's school who will be helping each week with the lunches. We need people to make soup on each of the Friday's, so please sign the list in the porch if you can help

**Stations of the Cross** – Friday's in Hinckley at 6.00pm, Sundays at 6.30pm in Hinckley (Mar.10; Apr.14) Market Bosworth (Mar.24; Apr.7.11) and Earl Shilton (Mar.17,31). If any group would like to lead the Stations on a Friday evening, please sign the list in the porch.

**Lenten Fast Day – Friday March 15** – the envelopes will be given out the weekend before and will be collected after Masses over the next weekend. The CAFOD boxes which will also be distributed at the beginning of Lent are for your loose change during Lent and will be collected after Easter. Mr.Paul Scola will speak briefly about our Lenten project at the end of Masses this weekend.

**Baptism Preparation** - for families wishing to have their children baptised in the near future, the two necessary preparation sessions will be run by Rev.Robin and Marina today and next Sunday at 4.30pm in the Mary Forryan Centre. No baptism will be arranged until the parents have attended the two mandatory preparation sessions. The next preparatory sessions will be in May.
